Rules of Play



### **French Roulette**

#### The table (betting field)

This is where the game is played, either by personally placing your chips on your chosen bet or handing it over to the croupier with the corresponding statement (normally only for the number field).

### The bets

#### **Even money bets**


All 18 red or all 18 black numbers on the wheel.

All 18 even or all 18 odd numbers.

All 18 numbers in the upper half of the number field (manque) or all 18 numbers in the lower half of the number field (passe).

Odds: 1:1

If zero (0) comes up, all even money bets made are blocked, i.e. their value is reduced by half.



Once all odds for the respective bets have been paid, the player can once again use his winning pot.

Odds: 2:1

here e.g. 1, 4, 7, 10 ... 31, 34

**Odds:** 2:1


## **Standard games**

Position on the number field

Wheel series

Big series, small series, orphans

Position on the wheel






#### Zero games (4 chips)

Position on the wheel





**Neighbours:** a number and its neighbours on the wheel, e.g. "14 two neighbours" or "14-2-2" (5 chips)

Position on the wheel

Position on the number field





This is also possible with "1-1" (3 chips), "3-3" (7 chips) and "4-4" (9 chips)

#### **Number field games**

7/9 game (6 chips)



#### **Finales**

e.g. finale 7 (3 chips)



or finale 3/6 (4 chips)



#### **American Roulette**

American Roulette is mainly played with American chips. These are available in different colours at the table.

Simply ask the croupier for a free colour. You determine the value of your colour yourself and the croupier marks your colours with the corresponding value chip. In the interest of a faster game, the players place their bets themselves whenever possible.

The numbers on the so-called racetrack are arranged in the same order as on the roulette wheel, making it much easier to place neighbour bets. You will also find the fields for the big series, small series, orphans and zero game here.

When you want to finish your game and leave the table, the croupier must first exchange your American chips back to value chips, as the value of your colour is only marked at this table and so are only valid here. These chips can only later be changed back at the table minimum.

## Wiesbadener Superzahl®

There's something very special in Wiesbaden: our super number, this increases the chances of winning at roulette in your favour. Every time our super number fanfare sounds at "your" table, the pay-out ratio on the bets in the numbered field is 1:2 up to 1:5. Without any additional stake!

**Double Win** 





If a pair (like the two 33s in the example here) comes up on the reel display of your table and the ball also falls into the 33 slot on the roulette wheel, the fanfare sounds and anyone is paid **double** the money on their winning bet in the numbered field.

**Triple Win** 





If three numbers (like the three 13s in the example here) appear on the reel display of your table and the ball also falls into the 13 slot on the roulette wheel, the fanfare sounds and anyone is paid **three times** the money on their winning bet in the numbered field.

**Quadruple Win** 

21 20 21 21 21



If four numbers (like the four 21s in the example here) appear on the reel display of your table and the ball also falls into the 21 slot on the roulette wheel, the fanfare sounds and anyone is paid **four times** the money on their winning bet in the numbered field.

**Quintuple Win** 

9 9 9 9 9



If five numbers (like the five 9s in the example here) appear on the reel display of your table and the ball also falls into the 9 slot on the roulette wheel, the fanfare sounds and anyone is paid **five times** the money on their winning bet in the numbered field.

The pay-out rate in roulette has an average of 97.3%, making it the highest pay out of all gambling games according to the 'Stiftung Warentest' (a German consumer organisation and foundation involved in investigating and comparing goods and services in an unbiased way). Thanks to the Wiesbadener Superzahl®, this increases to over 98% - a worldwide one-off.

**Maximum** (The maximum permissible bet for the respective option with the given table minimum.)
